

2018 Newtown Bookshop Summer Reading Club Contract

This form must be completed in order to reserve a place for your child in a group. Please read our policies carefully. We cannot make exceptions and your deposit is non-refundable.

- 1) All groups require a \$70 **non-refundable** deposit from you in order to reserve your child's place in a group.
- 2) Children should read the week's book before coming to class.
- 3) All of the books for each group are on display in the store. Since reading levels and interests can vary from child to child, the best way to select a group is to allow your child to examine the books on display.
- 4) Even if your child is an advanced reader, please do not register your child for a group with older children. In our experience, children who are not the same age as the other kids in their group are often left out.
- 5) The goal of the Newtown Bookshop summer book clubs is to teach children the intrinsic delights of reading solely for enjoyment.
- 6) Despite being led by experienced teachers, the groups are neither academic nor remedial in nature. If your child wishes to be in a grade level group, but has difficulty reading the required books, we ask that you read them with your child at home in preparation for each meeting.
- 7) Before you register, please make sure that your child wishes to participate and will not be disruptive. We reserve the right to remove a disruptive child from a club without a refund.
- 8) All book selections and selected times are final. If your child must miss a week, we cannot guarantee there will be space in another club for a makeup, but please ask and we will check. We cannot issue refunds for any classes your child misses.
- 9) You must pick your child up when the group is over. We are not responsible for children left unattended.
- 10) Groups may meet outside, in a shaded courtyard, except during thunderstorms, when we will move inside.
- 11) For legal reasons, teachers cannot administer medical attention or medications to your child. If there is the possibility that your child could require medication, including but not limited to and inhaler, an epi-pen, insulin, etc, then YOU the parent MUST be nearby to administer such medications at all times. Teachers are not trained for such matters, so do not leave medications with them. Due to the prevalence of food allergies, we ask that no child bring any unauthorized snacks to the book clubs.
- 12) Clubs that have enrollment of less than five children will be cancelled by June 19th. We will issue full refunds to all who reserved spots in any cancelled clubs. Encourage your friends to join you!

Summer Reading Clubs will begin meeting Tuesday, June 26th and meet through Thursday, August 9th (no classes from July 3rd – July 5th).
